Ukraine schools attacked: 750 schools (UNICEF) ■ Ukraine hospitals attacked: 64 hospitals (WHO) Ukrainian refugees: 3.7 million + ■ Internally displaced people: 6.5 million + • Russian soldiers killed:  $1,300 \sim 15,000$ 

■ Russian protesters arrested: 15,000+ in 151 cities Russians fleeing abroad:  $\sim 200,000$  (BBC/Jazeera)
